About Inês Correia de Sá, M.D.

Dr. Inês Correia de Sá is an expert in **Plastic, Reconstructive and Aesthetic Surgery**.

She received her Medical Degree from **Faculty of Medicine of University of Oporto** and she is an assistant of the discipline **Surgery – Clinical Practice (6th year)** on that University.

Her surgical training included a residency in Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery at Centro Hospitalar de São João, Porto, and several fellowships abroad. She is presently working as an attendee in Centro Hospitalar de São João.

She lectured **Pharmacology I, Pharmacology II, and Therapeutics and Clinical Pharmacology** on Medicine School for more than 12 years.

She is currently a **scientific researcher** at the Faculty of Medicine, University of Porto, where she is developing clinical and research projects in wound healing and inflammation fields. This project already won several awards and research grants. She is also involved in research work with the Laboratory of Pharmaceutical Technology of Faculty of Pharmacy of University of Porto. This project is focused on the development of new forms for percutaneous administration and penetration of drugs.

Part of her training was held in world-renowned centers such as the **Manhattan Eye, Ear & Throat Hospital (Meeth) in New York** (Dr. Sherrell J. Aston, Dr. Nicolas Tabbal, Dr. Alan Matarrasso) in **Private Clinics in New York** (Dr. Lawrence Bass, Dr. Daniel Baker, Dr. John Sibert, Dr. David Rosenberg, Dr. Sam Rizk and Dr. Philip J. Miller) and **Private Clinics in Boston** (Dr. Michael Yaremchuk Dr. Joel J. Feldman and Dr. Daniel Del Vecchio).

In these centers, she had the opportunity to reinforce her knowledge and expertise on **Facial and Body Aesthetic Surgery**.

In addition, she also devoted herself on breast reconstruction and lymphedema surgery treatment, reconstruction of craniofacial malformations, microsurgery and hand surgery. With this intend, her surgical training included fellowships in the **Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center in New York**, in the **Miami Children's Hospital** and in the **Stanford University in San Francisco**.

Dr. Inês Correia de Sá often takes part on courses focused on the latest surgical techniques. Over the past years, she as lectured extensively on her research in both national and international meetings (including some before the American Society for Aesthetic Plastic Surgery). She has over 30 scientific publications **in international renowned refereed journals in the field of Plastic Surgery**.

She is often invited as a reviewer for scientific papers and is a member of the editorial board of an **international journal**.

In her private practice, she mainly devotes to Face and Body Aesthetic Surgery including rhinoplasty, blepharoplasty, cervico-facial lift, otoplasty, genioplasty, breast lift, reduction mammoplasty, abdominoplasty, liposuction, cruoplastia, brachioplasty and liposculpture with fat grafts.

She also performs minimally invasive rejuvenation procedures such as wrinkle or facial fillers, Botox application,

treatment of hyperhidrosis, facial peelings, facial mesotherapy, etc.

She also preforms all sort of reconstructive procedures, including breast reconstruction, craniofacial reconstruction, microsurgery, and hand lower limb reconstruction.
